Learn More About General Conference 2019

As some of you may already have heard by now, the United Methodist Church will be having a special **Called Session of the General Conference** on **February 23-26** in St. Louis, Missouri.

The General Conference is the primary legislative body of the United Methodist Church. It usually meets once every four years, gathering elected delegates from churches all over the world, who will then vote on doctrine and legislation, creating our Book of Discipline (the UMC's church law). The General Conference is the only group that can speak on behalf of the entire United Methodist Church.

The last regular General Conference met in 2016 in Portland, Oregon. And the next regular session will be in 2020. However, in just over a month, we will have a special Called Session of the General Conference to consider matters of human sexuality. At this meeting, they will consider a variety of legislative options, ranging from approving same-sex marriage to dividing into new separate denominations to simply maintaining the current Book of Discipline.

If you're interested in learning more about this General Conference and the legislation being proposed, there will be an **Information Session** on **Sunday, February 3, at 10 a.m.** in the sanctuary in between services.

There will also be a **Follow-Up Question & Answer** time on Wednesday, February 6, at 6 p.m. in the Chapel.

Sunday Night Youth

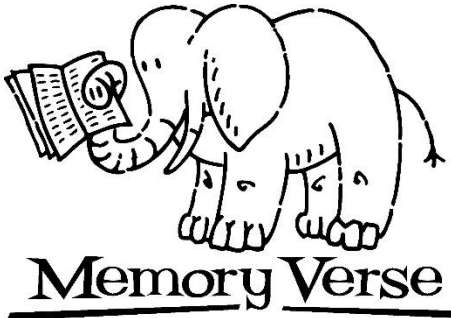
