

## Sunday Night Youth



## **TIPS ON PACKING YOUR SHOE BOXES**

**Due November 17, 2019**

1. Use new items.
2. Each box stands alone, so don't divide items between two boxes.
3. Include some "fun" in every box.
4. Remove all wrappings from your items.
5. A toothbrush may be put in a zip lock bag. No candy or tooth paste because there is a used by date on them.
6. Include your check for \$9.00 for each box you pack. You may also go on line and pay by credit card where you will get a tracking number strip to print out and attach to the shoebox. You can track the number until it reaches the country of its destination.

If you do multiple boxes just write one check and put in one of the boxes. Place the boy or girl strip at either end of the top of the box. Later these boxes will be taped around the middle for shipment so don't put the label in the middle.
