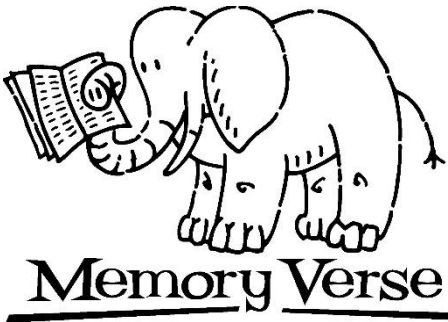
Sunday Night Youth

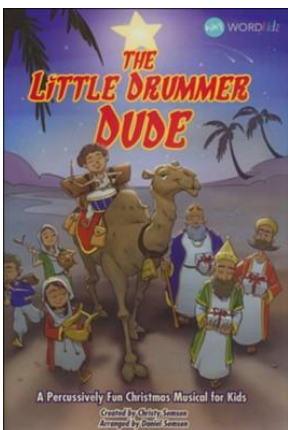
