I could not believe it when I heard all that had been donated, and it meant the world to me when Mrs. Tera told me all that had been collected by the children during Vacation Bible School! This year we took the most supplies and donations ever! We gifted \$10,000 in donations, took 800 pounds of supplies, and worked with seven different ministries! We distributed everything throughout the orphanages, farm, and people that came to the farm the day we were there, while also giving to the handicapped ministry and the women's ministry. It was incredible! The Cubans were so thankful and in complete awe of what we had brought them, a lot of which came from you. Everything we did and everywhere we went was a blessing not only to Cuba but to our whole team in many different ways!

It was a truly life-changing experience, and I wanted to share a few of things I learned on this trip! Several of the experiences I learned about were serving, the power of prayer, and the kind of joy that Christ offers, something the world could never give! I learned that joy does not come from what you have on the outside but from what you have within, and I learned that it is so much better to give than receive whether it be in your work or just giving your time to encourage someone. One of the biggest things that I learned is that if you walk by the flesh you will easily become tired, but if you walk by the Spirit, He will renew your strength and give you energy. God is still teaching me something new every day; He is still molding me and shaping me, and I am still growing through Him! I am so thankful for each of you in this church, all your encouragement, and everything that you sent with me! The lives of the people in Cuba and the people on our team were changed, including mine, while miracles took place! Everything that you did was a blessing in more than one way, and I am truly thankful to have each one of you as a part of my life! Thank you so much again!

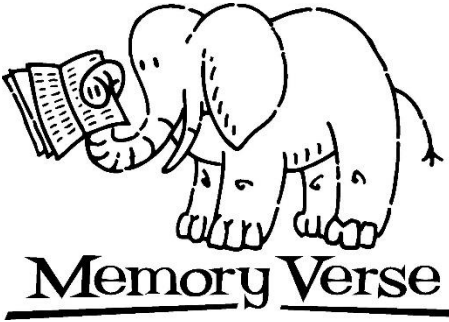
Sunday Night Youth
